Am Shalom will call itself “Scent-Sitive”. This policy will evolve as the law and the needs of our congregants’ changes. For the time being the board likes the way Temple Sinai phrases it. The notice will be included with our weekly email and any handouts as well as posted at the synagogue. As we are a small congregation we cannot assign a separate “scent-free area” in our sanctuary so being sensitive to the issue is what the board decided they can do.
